MEASURES FOR SELF-EMPLOYED PERSONS

A temporary income provision and business loan is available for self-employed residents in Amstelveen. The temporary income provision consists of:

- Income support for 3 months (supplement to income up to the social minimum, single person € 1,052 per month and for a family € 1,503 per month). It does not need to be refunded.
- A business capital loan up to a maximum of € 10,157. Repayment may be postponed. Contrary to the Assistance Decree for self-employed persons, the city does not assess the viability of the company, the income of any other people registered at the same residence or your assets.

Only visit the waste collection station if you really need to

It is currently particularly busy at the waste collection station. We therefore urge you to only come to the waste collection station if you really need to. This prevents long lines.

Boemerang does not currently collect useful items from the waste collection station. The municipality advises you to keep these old items at home or take them directly to Boemerang.




Be aware!

Strict measures are in place!

Keep 1.5 metres distance

To fight the coronavirus, we must obey the rules together. Follow the instructions of the local government: keep 1.5 metres away from each other! Are you sick or do you have a cold? Stay at home. Protect yourself and those around you. You can go outside, do groceries or walk the dog in the park, but make sure to keep 1.5 metres distance from others.



- No events and gatherings are permitted until June 1, 2020.
- Any sick person in your family? Everybody must stay at home.
- Law enforcement will act if 3 or more persons fail to obey the rules, such as the 1.5 metre distance.

In case of violation, you may be fined for € 400!
